

*The Codex Alimentarius Commission and Energy Healers Editorial by John Gilbert, Ph.D.

Any alternative health care product or service that replaces any pharmaceutical drug is slowly being phased out by CAC, FDA and licensing agencies in the USA. The only energy healers under direct attack now are those who are very visible in their efforts to replace pharmaceuticals and those who are in direct and illegal competition with licensed massage therapists. Over the next two years this will change dramatically as CAC and the FDA implement CAC guidelines more and more. Energy healers who want to save their profession and protect their income will need to make several changes in the way they do business.

Those professional energy healers currently licensed as massage therapists will probably not be affected by Codex Alimentarius unless they use essential oils in their practice. If that's your case, you may want to consider becoming licensed as a spiritual healer as described below.

Unlicensed energy healers will no longer be able to market their services that compete directly with a drug. Therefore, you might want to consider becoming licensed as a spiritual healer through an internationally recognized spiritual healer licensing board that includes energy healing within their spiritual practices. There are two such agencies as on this writing: 1) The Alliance of Christian Healers License Board for practicing Christians, and 2) The Spiritual Health Coach License Board for spiritual healers of all faiths. Both organizations teach spiritual coach skills.

If you would like to stop the federal government from implementing the Codex Treaty, I suggest you subscribe to the newsletter at Health Freedom USA and stay informed. Then take whatever action is necessary to save your profession. At the same time, I suggest you protect yourself against the possibility the Codex Treaty is fully implemented.

Here's the recommended strategy for protecting yourself:

- Become a licensed spiritual healer by a recognized licensing agency
- Take an accredited course in spiritual coaching
- Create and use an informed consent form
- Join a natural therapies or spiritual healers association

If you practice anything else, become certified or licensed in that area of expertise too. Your primary purpose is to protect your income and save your job from extinction. Do anything reasonably necessary to serve that purpose. If you also provide aromatherapy, biofeedback, homeopathic, hypnotism, naturopathic, nutrition, reflexology, spiritual or other alternative health care services, it's to your advantage to become certified or licensed in that specialty.
